Bat, and bear.

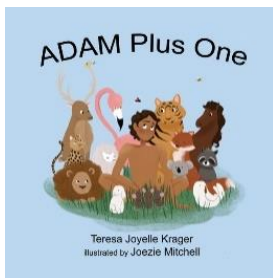
Tadpole, frog
